



Glasgow Life is looking for clubs and organisations who want to support care experienced young people to participate in local activities. We know that our young people have a wealth of talent and ability and we're looking for excellent organisations that can unlock their potential.

Glasgow Life will cover the costs for the young person's participation in the activity. This scheme is supported by the Life Changes Trust and is being delivered in partnership with Glasgow City Council and Young Scot.

Organisations can register with us to become known as a FAB provider. We will promote your activities and provide you with a hand held barcode reader (if necessary) to allow young people to use their Young Scot card to track participation.

WHO IS IT FOR?

The FAB project is aimed at young people aged 14-26, care experienced and living in the South of the city or where their family is in the south.

Being 'care experienced' means that a young person or their family has required support. In some cases young people remain at home, whilst in others, they live away from their parents.

CARE EXPERIENCE INCLUDE:

- Kinship care – for instance living with gran or aunty
- Looked after at home – with the help of social work
- Residential unit and foster care
- Care leavers
- Young people in continuing or aftercare

WHAT'S IN IT FOR PROVIDERS?

AS A FAB PROVIDER, YOU WILL GET:

- Agreed cost covered for the young person's participation
- A profile on the FAB web portal, in partnership with Young Scot
- Promotion of your activities to young people
- Support and advice on working with care experienced young people
- The opportunity to meet and network with other providers
- The opportunity to participate in the evaluation of this scheme
